# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **Membership Information**

#### Q: At what age can I join the Club?

A: In accordance with *The Community Group Registry Program*, anyone 55+ years of age can join the Club.

### Q: How can I join the Club?

- A: Membership forms are on the notice board in the Seniors room. Please take a form, fill it out and follow the instructions written on the envelope.
  The notice board is only accessible when Club activities are in progress.

#### Q: How much does membership cost?

A: Membership is currently \$10 annually. The membership year is from October 1 – September 30.

### Q: Do I pay to attend activities?

A: Bingo is \$5.00 for a book of eight games per session. Line Dancing is \$2.00 each time you attend. There is a cost to travel on Bus Trips. See Trips & Outings below for bus contact info. All other activities are included in the membership. A calendar of activities is posted on the notice board in the seniors' room in the community centre. Click on the 'Events Calendar' tab on the website for the current months' calendar.

### Q: Do I pay to attend special functions?

- A: There is a nominal cost for special functions such as Christmas and Canada Day Luncheons.
- Q: If I join Meadowvale Seniors Social Club, does that include entrance to Meadowvale Community Centre programs?

- A: No. The two organizations are separate. The City of Mississauga Parks & Recreation sponsors the Community Centre space that the Seniors Club uses.
- Q: If I join Meadowvale Seniors Social Club, does that include entrance to other seniors clubs in Mississauga?
- A: No. Your membership is only valid at Meadowvale Seniors Social Club.
